CALL TO ORDER - The Genesee City Council met in regular session on May 21, 2013. Mayor Steve Odenborg called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

ROLL CALL – Present at the meeting were council members Cathleen Blevins, Ron Zenner, Ryan Banks and Linda James. City Employees Karyn Wright and Dustin Brinkly were also present.
