Will ONLY Accept Household Trash including ALL material items made of rubber or plastic, contaminated waste, treated lumber/railroad ties, tarps, canvas, tents, insulation, styrofoam, fiberglass, small appliances, microwaves/dishwashers, hot tubs, cfl light bulbs, solidified paint, Trex decking, upholstered furniture, mattresses or box springs, cardboard, twine, feed bags and clothing.

No Demolition, Tires or Metal in October at Deary, Genesee, Juliaetta or Potlatch Bulky Waste Sites.

8am - 4pm Specified Saturdays Only
April & October Household Waste Only

**Deary:** October 12th & 26th - Line St

Genesee: October 12th & 26th - Morscheck Rd

**Juliaetta**: October **5th** & **19th** - South on Hwy 3

Potlatch: October 5th & 19th - Turn onto Mill Rd

\*Troy/Moscow: October 12th & 26th - 3299 Hwy 8

\*Only site that accepts demolition waste, tires or metal in October is Solid Waste Processing Facility 3299 Hwy 8 E.
