Well 9 Update: The well drillers struck water at about 500' in the Wanapum aquifer several weeks ago. This is the upper aquifer that we have historically tapped into. They are going to continue to drill until we reach the Grande Ronde aquifer, which is the same one we tapped into for Well 8. We expect to hit water at around 900'. Drilling should start up again within the next few weeks.
