Tree Trimming Reminder: Before all of the rapid spring growth begins, we want to remind everyone of their responsibility to keep the sidewalks and intersections free of tree limbs that obstruct paths or impair traffic. City code states that tree limbs must be at least 7.5 feet from the surface of the sidewalk or driveway and at least 12 feet from the surface of the roadway. This is addressed in Title 9 Chapter 2 Section 9.
