**Move Garbage Carts:** With all of the recent wintry weather we have had, it is important to promptly remove garbage carts from the street after they are emptied on Mondays. It is very difficult for our city maintenance crew to clear the streets of snow when the garbage carts are on the street. Please be sure to move them as soon as you are able. **Spring Clean Up and Compost!** As spring approaches, we want to remind everyone about the compost bins that are available 24/7 off Morscheck Rd on the west side of town for all yard waste and untreated wood. You can also take your recyclable cardboard and cans there anytime. Please refrain from taking household garbage to the bulky waste site as it will not be collected from there. If you have large household items to dispose of you can take them on the 2nd and 4th Saturday of each month. **Well 9 Update:** The drillers have made headway at the Well 9 location. They drilled down 540 feet and expect to reach the target depth of 900 feet by Mid-March. The well should be cased and developed in April.

Wastewater Project Update: Our new wastewater treatment plant is projected to be completed this June. The crews are working on electrical, pressure testing, and controls. They will conduct seepage tests to ensure the lagoons are functioning properly as soon as all of the ice has melted. As long as all of the tests come back clear, they will be able to move forward with finishing the rest of the system.
