Did you know? Genesee home owners are responsible for the maintenance and upkeep of all sidewalks adjacent to their property. Well 9 Update : Great news, we found water !! The driller reached a depth of 955' on April 25th and the well is producing more water than we hoped for. The next step will be to case the well and install the well screens, at that point we will pump test the well to determine the actual gallons per minute it will produce.

Home Improvement Season: The weather is nice and it's a great time for making home improvements. Did you know that most improvements require a permit? Please check in with City Hall before you start work to make sure you have the necessary permits ready. This enables proper inspections to take place and prevents the frustration of having to stop work or remove structures that may accidentally end up in the City's right of way.

Open Burn Season ends May 31st. This is a great time to clear your yard of limbs and debris that can be burned. Please be considerate of your neighbors and make sure you are not burning wet yard waste that will be too smokey.
