Approval of Bills Paid, Financial Statement, Journal Entries, Adjustments and Bank Statements

Motion made by Bill to accept the consent agenda as presented seconded by Jesse. Roll call vote: Bailey, Aherin, Krick, Mader all ayes. Motion carries.

NEW BUSINESS: Closing P1FCU 2 Account (Action Item) – John clarified that this account was left open when the City was transferring money down to the local investment funds. This is not the LGIP account. The remaining funds will be allocated appropriately. **Motion made by Bill to approve closing P1FCU 2 Account, seconded by Cody. Roll call vote: Bailey, Aherin, Krick, Mader all ayes. Motion carries.**

INTRODUCTION, READINGS AND ADOPTION OF ORDINANCES & RESOLUTIONS

Resolution 2025-5 Building Permit Fees (Action Item) – Motion made by Cody to suspend the 3 readings of Resolution 2025-5; Roll call vote: Bailey, Aherin, Krick, Mader all ayes. Motion carries.

John closed the Public Hearing at 6:06 P.M

Motion made by Cody to approve resolution 2025-5 as presented; seconded by Bill. Roll call vote: Bailey, Aherin, Krick, Mader all ayes. Motion carries. Resolution 2025-5 is available for public inspection at City Hall.

CITY OFFICIAL, COUNCIL AND STAFF REPORTS

Mayor Update: 10/8/25 is the AIC Fall meeting in Moscow. John is unable to attend.

Bill Krick – Water and Sewer Update: Seeding was completed 10/4/25. Dustin reported that they had to dewater the 2 concrete structures to make repairs. There was still leaking after the repair so more seals have been ordered. The SARF has been repaired and is functioning well. No further failures have been identified. DEQ Permit Update: The new IPDES permit was issued 10/3/2025 allowing Genesee to discharge to the creek 11/1/2025. DEQ agreed to allow Genesee to operate under the current Ammonia limits and not

implement the new ammonia limit until September of 2026. Dr. Coats comments on the draft permit were taken into consideration and DEQ removed the ammonia mass loading limit from the permit. Dustin said he will set up a meeting with Ryan at Merrick to discuss decommissioning the old lagoon, addressing the reuse pump issue, and an unsettled Merrick bill.

Cody Bailey – Street Update: Stripco completed crosswalk painting last week. Paving was completed. Dustin will reach out to Darian to address completing the shoulder work. Cody also reported that Genesee School District is putting in a parking lot behind the daycare. To complete the parking lot, they had to do a bunch of dirt work and remove some trees along Hazel. The school has exhausted their funds for the project. Cody Kinyon reached out to the city with a quote of \$2000 to complete stabilizing the bank and removing stumps before we lose it into the street. Cody approved this and Dustin has contacted Kinyon to complete the work.

Jesse Aherin – Administrative Update: Annual reviews need to be completed before next council meeting on October 21, 2025. Taylor will collect money for youth sports registration at City Hall.

Jessica Mader – Parks Update: Wood chips have been delivered for the City Park. Grant application has been submitted. Only 1 proposal can be submitted per quarter. The splash pad was submitted first. The skatepark proposal will be submitted next. RV dump grant opens in October.

Dustin Brinkly- Public Works Update: None


