NEW BUSINESS: Liquor License Renewals (Action Item): Taylor confirmed that all businesses have received their Idaho State and Latah County liquor licenses in addition to paying the renewal fees. **Motion made by Bill to approve the liquor license renewals for 2026; seconded by Jesse. Roll call vote: Aherin, Krick, Mader all ayes. Motion carries.**

Genesee Super Market LLC Business License (Action Item): **Motion made by Bill to approve the Genesee Super Market LLC business license; seconded by Jessica. Roll call vote: Aherin, Krick, Mader all ayes. Motion carries.**

New City Truck Purchase (Action Item): Cody is not present to discuss. Dustin informed council that there has been some discussion regarding replacing the half ton that is currently in the shop. They are troubleshooting some possible electrical issues in addition to the transmission issues. The city is looking at replacing it with a 3/4 ton that we could put a plow on and outfitting it as more of a service truck. A new truck was budgeted for this year in addition to the vac truck purchase. **Motion made by Bill to table until next meeting; seconded by Jesse. Roll call vote: Aherin, Krick, Mader all ayes. Motion carries.**

H&H Copier Lease Renewal (Action Item): Current 5-year copier lease is due for renewal. There is an increase from \$115.00 to \$120.00 monthly. All services and supplies are covered in lease contract. **Motion made by Bill to approve the H&H copier lease; seconded by Jessica. Roll call vote: Aherin, Krick, Mader all ayes. Motion carries.**

Motion carries. Executive session entered at 6:19 p.m


