Spring Clean-Up Reminder: Genesee residents can take advantage of the Rural City Bulky Waste Program this April. The Genesee site (Morscheck Rd) will be open on Saturday, April 11th and 25th from 8:00 AM–4:00 PM and will accept household waste only. Accepted items include general household trash, plastics, furniture, mattresses, small appliances, and other non-hazardous materials. Please note that demolition debris, tires, metal, and e-waste will not be accepted at the Genesee site. Residents are limited to two trips per household, and large loads must be taken to the Moscow Transfer Station on the same dates.
