Bill Krick – Water and Sewer Update: Well 8 transducer that was sponsored by PVAC is no longer functioning and the replacement cost is about \$3900. The information the transducer collects is valuable. Dustin has reached out to PVAC to see if they would like to cost share the replacement. The lift stations on Saturday during the storms were not keeping up. Dustin has scheduled a time to meet with Merrick next week to discuss further. No updates on the Well House design.

Jessica Mader – Parks Update: Park bathroom doors are being replaced. Railroad ties are being placed to help contain the woodchips at the park. Jessica would like to address the fence that has fallen down on private property bordering the city park.
