**BURN SEASON:** Open Burn Season runs through May 31st. This is an ideal time to clear your yard of limbs and other burnable debris. Please be considerate of your neighbors by avoiding the burning of wet yard waste, which can create excessive smoke. For safety, never leave fires unattended, keep a water source or hose nearby, and ensure your burn is fully extinguished before leaving the area.

**BUILDING PERMITS:** With the warmer weather, it's a great time to start those projects around your home. Keep in mind that many improvements require a permit. Before beginning work, please check with City Hall to ensure you have the proper permits in place. This helps allow for necessary inspections and can prevent delays or the inconvenience of having to stop work or remove structures that may unintentionally extend into the City's right-of-way.
