Mayor Update: None

Bill Krick – Water and Sewer Update: Sewer - Last Tuesday 2 pigs were ran through the lines and there was an immediate increase in the flow and are back up to the production we had at the initial start-up. Saw mostly clay at the headworks. This is something we will need to do occasionally to keep up on maintenance. Water – Well house 9 is ready to go out for bid. Advertisement will go out 6/18 and bid opening is 7/9.

Cody Bailey – Street Update: Street sweeper is working great. Waiting to hear back from Knife River on timeline for the chip seal project. Crack seal project starts Thursday 6/18.

Jesse Aherin – Administrative Update: Received positive comments from citizens regarding how great the city looked for Community Day.

Jessica Mader – Parks Update: Fence repairs have not been completed yet. Wants to work on getting the 2nd RV dump completed by end of September.

Dustin Brinkly- Public Works Update: Working through the water meter grant. Costs have increased and budget is being reworked. Starting to work on FY26/27 budget to prepare for next council meeting.

Taylor Moody-Clerk's Update: None

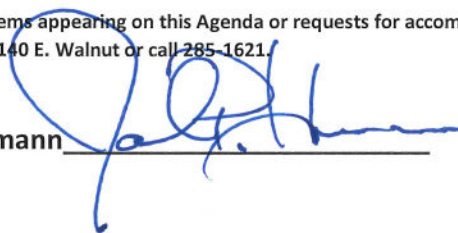
